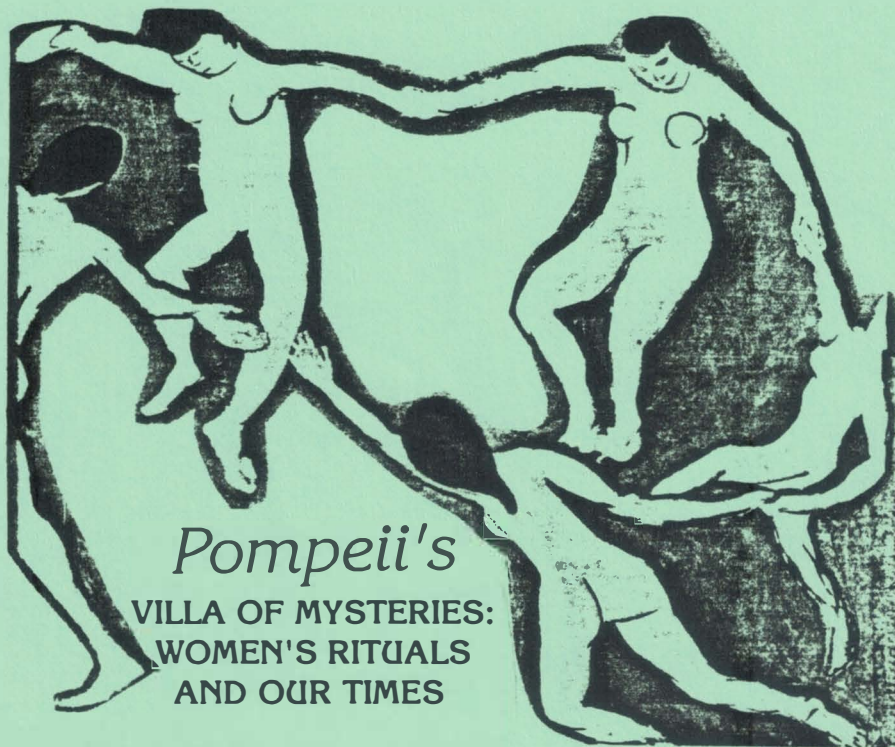


What can Pompeian women who lived 2000 years ago teach contemporary women about life passages?
